## Maritime Labour Notice (MLN) - 002

## Introduction to Maritime Labour Convention Notices

- 1. The Maritime Labour Convention (MLC) will come into force on 20<sup>th</sup> August 2013 and in preparation for this new convention the Gibraltar Maritime Administration have decided to issue a series of new guidance notices.
- 2. Consideration was given to incorporating these notices into the existing regime of Shipping Information Notices and or Shipping Guidance Notices, which covers the ships and their equipment.
- However the MLC has been called the fourth pillar of the International regime for shipping and as there is already a series of STCW Administrative Instructions it was decided the MLC Notice(MLN for short) should be separate.
- 4. The MLN will provide guidance on compliance with Gibraltar regulations which give effect to the MLC.
- 5. Implementation of these guidelines will be taken as evidence of compliance with the Gibraltar regulations.
- 6. The guidelines do not preclude the shipowner from demonstrating an equivalent or higher standard as an "alternative method" of evidence of compliance.
- 7. A Declaration of Maritime Labour Compliance, Part I and II has also been prepared and these are in editable form on the web site.
- 8. While this is not a new area, the MLC simply brings together many existing ILO Conventions, it is the first time these areas will have subject to a formal regime of inspection and certification.
- 9. The GMA would welcome feedback on any of the MLN's or the Declarations
