**Shipping Guidance Notice – 101**  
**Long-Range Identification & Tracking (LRIT) Systems**

This Shipping Guidance Notice is to inform Masters, Managers, and Operators of Gibraltar registered ships which may be fitted with more than one LRIT system capable of the transmission of mandatory position reports, of the following Gibraltar Maritime Administration's requirements in this respect:

- Each individual system must have a valid Conformance Test Report (CTR) issued by one of the approved ASP's;
- Every system having LRIT capability must be declared to the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority on application/renewal/amendment of the Ship's Station Licence;
- The Administration must at all times be kept informed of the system actively transmitting the mandatory position reports. Email notifications in this respect should be sent to;
